Vatican City, announced on Friday, June 19, 2020 that Pope Francis appointed Fr. John Persaud, as Bishop for the Diocese of Mandeville, Jamaica. Fr. Persaud who is a Diocesan Priest of the Diocese of Georgetown, since 1985, has served the Diocese of Georgetown in various capacities: being Parish priest, Vicar General, Vicar for Clergy, Judicial Vicar, among other positions.

He also served the Caribbean as Judicial Vicar of the Eastern Antilles Inter-Diocesan Tribunal and also as General Secretary of the Antilles Episcopal Conference.

As soon as Fr. Persaud can travel to Jamaica, he will visit Mandeville to meet with the Apostolic Administrator, Archbishop Emeritus Charles Dufour of Kingston, clergy, religious and the faithful to begin preparations for his Episcopal Ordination
